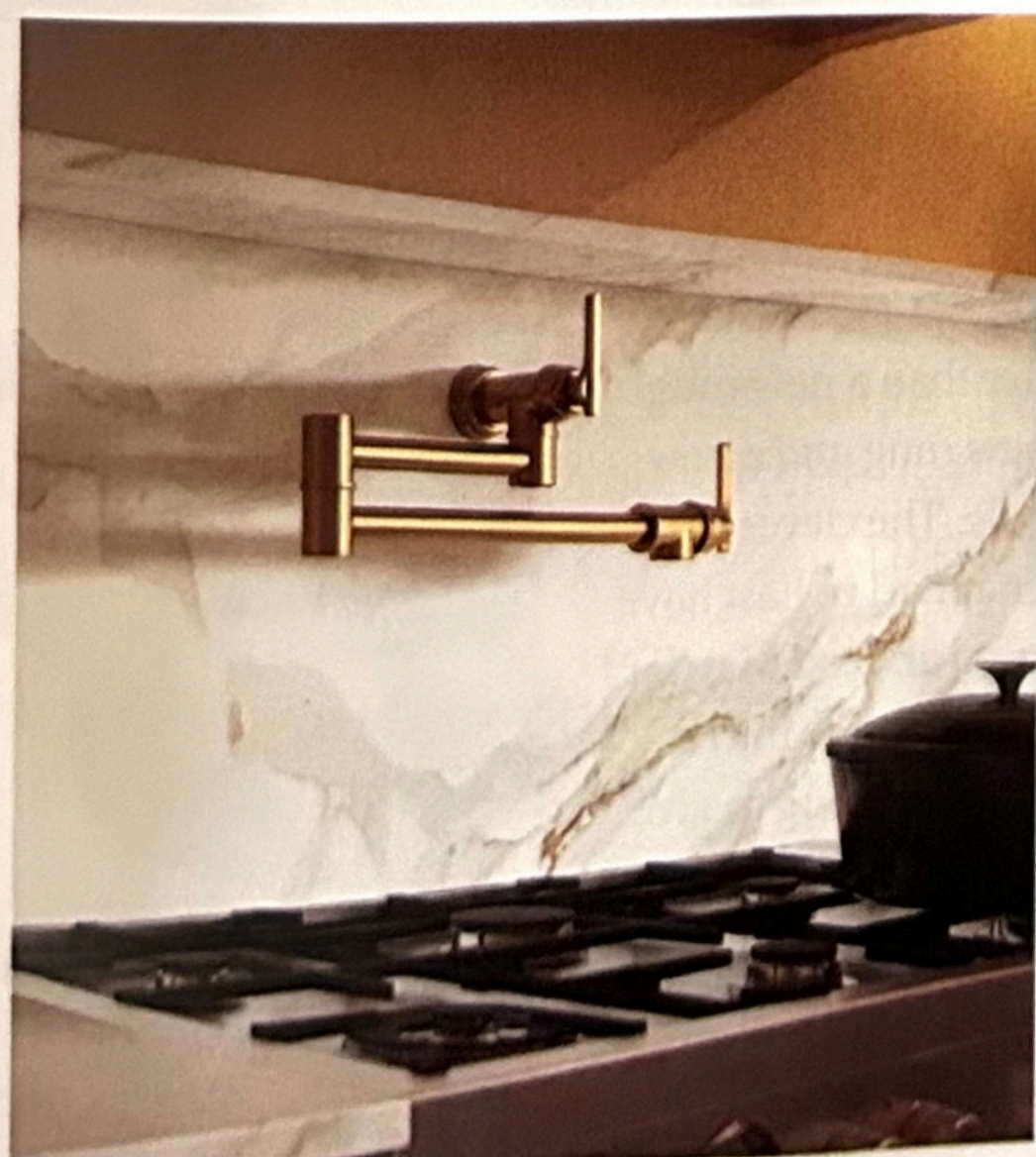
### Earn your stripes
