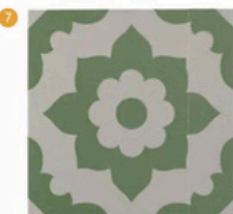
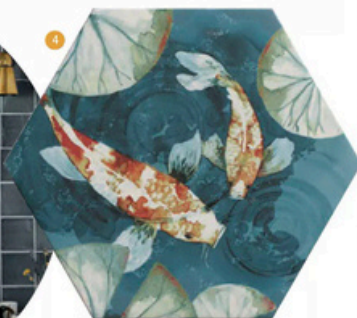
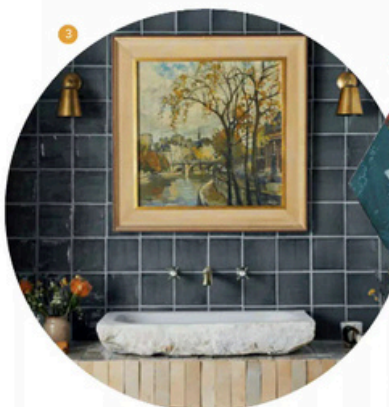




## TILES
