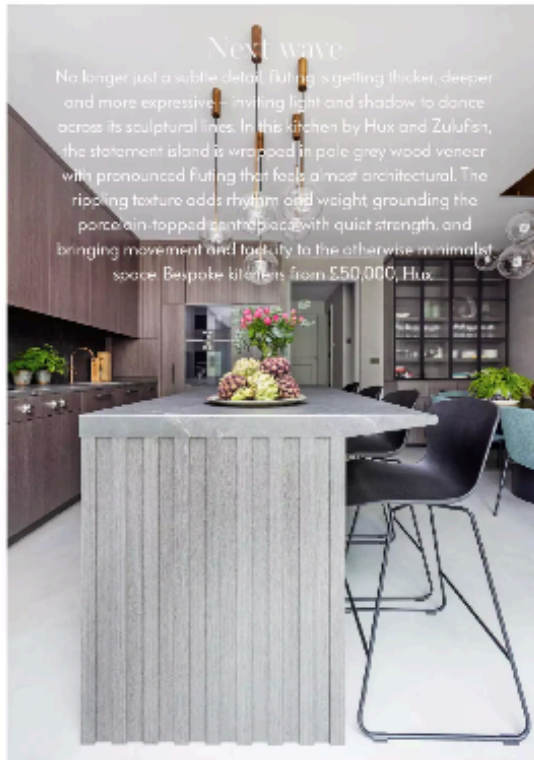

No longer just a subtle detail, fluting is getting thicker, deeper and more expressive, inviting light and shadow to dance across its sculptural lines. In this kitchen by Hux and Zulufin, the statement island is wrapped in pale grey wood veneer with pronounced fluting that feels almost architectural. The rippling texture adds rhythm and weight, grounding the porcelain-topped centrepiece with quiet strength, and bringing movement and tactility to the otherwise minimalist space.
