IN THE CUPBOARDS

If you find yourself walking a tightrope between the pull of playful maximalism and serene, calm minimalism, here's a solution that does both: clever cabinetry. When closed, visual noise is muted and clutter is cleared away; but once opened up, the party can ensue. Case in point: this lobster-hued home bar, tucked behind cool, contemporary doors. Created by Hux London, this bespoke number (made-to-order from a Buckinghamshire workshop) brings a bit of mischief, not to mention a fun party trick bound to impress. But the starlet of the cabinetry world is more quotidian: meet the do-it-all cupboard. This interior design big-dog squirrels away breakfast provisions, kitchen gadgets et al. Make yours a coffee station, like interior design firm Pringle & Pringle have done, or for a mini pantry, try Neptune for customisable freestanding larders. And for the rest of the home? Be inspired by interior designer Christian Bense's neatly stowed-away vanity unit – a luxurious-yet-functional addition to a guest bedroom which, better still, takes up hardly any space at all.
